INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE 2024: "Decoding Affordable Housing: From Dimensions to Dignity"

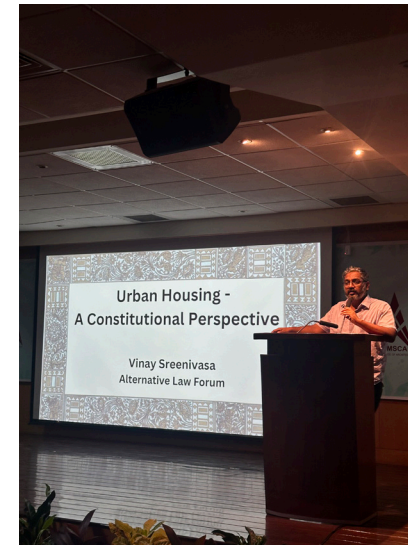
Decoding Affordable Housing
From Dimensions to Dignity

BMSCA, in collaboration with the Bangalore Chamber for Industries and Commerce (BCIC), hosted a one-day International conference on May 3, 2024, focusing on urban housing for the poor. The conference explored redefining income categories and evaluated existing spatial standards for the Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and Low-Income Groups (LIGs). Attendees analysed international case studies, assessed the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY), and gathered user opinions on housing challenges in India. The discussions

provided valuable insights into developing practical spatial standards for marginalized urban communities.

The proceedings from the conference, including selected papers, has been published with an ISBN and submitted to BCIC. This will aid in shaping policies to create feasible housing parameters that address the needs of the urban poor.

The event featured eminent speakers such as Prof. Vinayak Bharne from the School of Architecture, University of Southern California, USA, and Mr. Vinay Sreenivasa, an advocate and activist from the Alternative Law Forum. The conference saw participation from 181 registered individuals, including industry professionals, and research scholars, with 11 papers selected for presentation. The event took place at the BMSA Auditorium.



Heritage Documentation Tour

BMSCA conducted a Heritage Documentation tour from April 19th to 21st, 2024 as part of their participation in the Heritage Awards 2024, organized by INTACH, aimed at recognizing excellence in documenting interdisciplinary and unprotected heritage. The INTACH award seeks to raise awareness about India's architectural heritage among students and faculty.

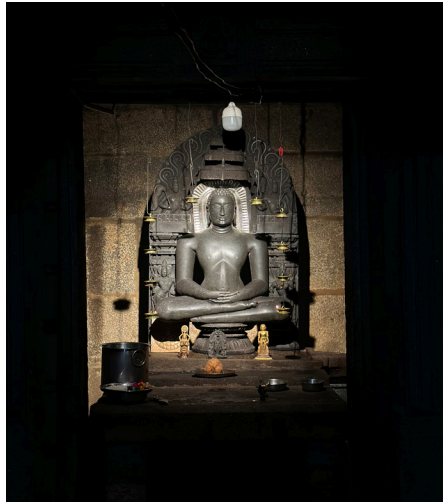


A team of 5 faculty members and 20 students from various semesters visited the Varanga Jain Temple in Udupi, Karnataka, a prominent 12th-century heritage site. The team conducted detailed on-site documentation, capturing both tangible and intangible elements of the temple precinct. This comprehensive effort resulted in measured drawings and insights from local scholars, enhancing the understanding of the site's cultural and architectural significance.

The students meticulously documented the site, including plans, sections, elevations, and details, and explored its cultural importance through local narratives and associations. Their work was translated into graph sheets, digital drawings, and sketches, contributing to the preservation and recognition of this valuable heritage site.

Abstract: This thesis project explores the challenges faced by street vendors in Guwahati, India, with a focus on local and tribal vendors, majority of them being women. It highlights the significance of periodic markets (Saptarik Bazaars) in providing affordable fresh produce but acknowledges the issues of informal street vending, such as pedestrian obstruction and traffic-related problems. The research emphasizes the need of a formal marketplace with essential amenities to improve livelihoods, promote cultural inclusiveness, and foster unity among diverse vendor communities as 74% of the city's markets are currently residing on the roadside without any essential amenities. Most of the Tribal Women vendors come from Matrilineal Societies which makes them the sole bread earners for their families, and they face obstacles like inadequate infrastructure and unhygienic conditions when they come to vend in the city, which affects not only their income but also the overall economy of the State. The methodology included a base study to identify the challenges, surveys, interviews, literature review, and site analysis, to explore sustainable solutions for providing a safe and secure vending atmosphere with essential amenities for street vendors in Guwahati.

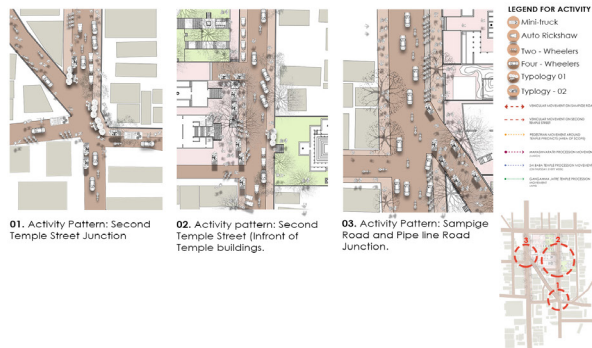

Mapping of Physical conditions



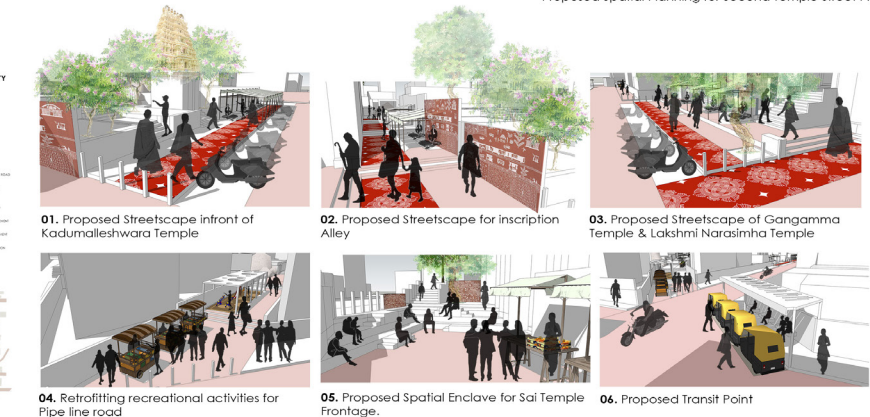
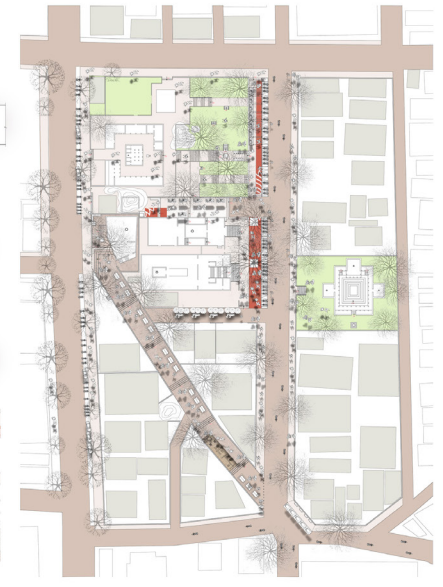
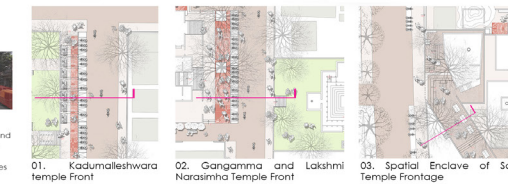
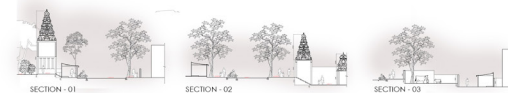
Mapping of Activity Pattern

Malleshwaram Anubhava – PG Studio Work Rejuvenation of Conservancy Lanes

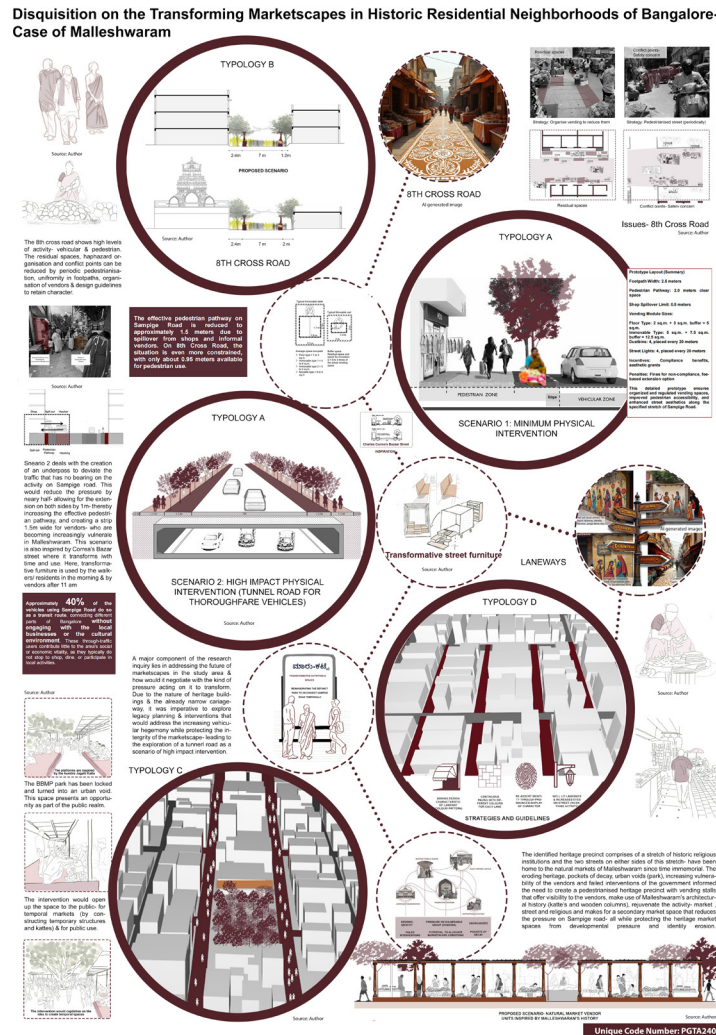
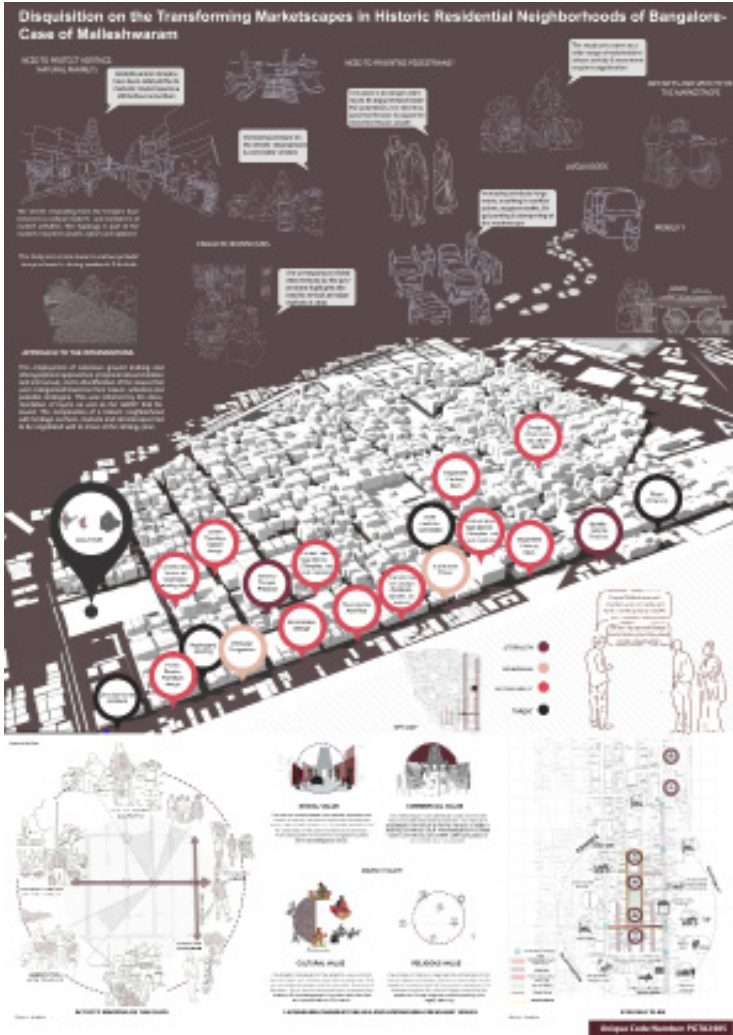
This project seeks to transform the often-overlooked conservancy lanes of Malleshwaram into vibrant, community-oriented spaces. Originally used as backyard lanes for human waste collection, and later repurposed for parking and waste dumping due to their narrow width, these lanes have remained underutilized despite their potential to enhance neighborhood life. The intervention reimagines these lanes as active, pedestrian-friendly pathways with multiple amenities. Alongside pedestrian zones, the plans include pocket gardens, pet parks, book corners, plant nurseries, play areas, interactive and retractable game zones, and an obstacle gaming course to engage people of all ages. The project also emphasizes environmental sustainability, with plans for efficient waste management and permeable surfaces to support rainwater infiltration. Enhanced with greenery and effective lighting, these revitalized lanes aim to foster community interaction, support ecological sustainability, and create new social spaces in quiet residential areas.
